

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Sarepta met in regular session Tuesday, January 8, 2019 at 6:00 p.m., in the Municipal Building, Sarepta, LA.

Mayor Adkins called the meeting to order and Heath Warford opened with prayer. Michael Corley led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Requests for additions to the agenda were called for and unanswered.

Public comments were called for and unanswered.

Michael Corley made a motion to approve the agenda as printed, seconded by Melanie Dean. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Claire Lay read the minutes from the December regular meeting. Heath Warford made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Claire Lay seconded the motion. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Financial Statements of all funds, including a current budget vs. actual, were presented. Michael Corley made a motion to approve financial statements as presented, motion seconded by Heath Warford. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Mayor Adkins asked for a recommendation for 2019 season Summer Ball Director. Heath Warford made a motion to hire Jason Martin as Summer Ball Director, seconded by Claire Lay. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Mayor Adkins explained the need to start training another part-time wastewater employee to act as a substitute and to do the Town bush hogging. She recommended Charles L. Grappe. Michael Corley made a motion to hire Charles L. Grappe at a starting rate of \$10.00 an hour, seconded by Melanie Dean. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Mayor Adkins asked for approval for Alderman Michael Corley, Clerk Amanda Anglin, and herself to attend the LMA Mid-Winter Conference in February. Melanie Dean made a motion to approve attending the conference, seconded by Claire Lay. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Mayor Adkins opened discussion about current sewer issues and possible solutions. These problems will have to be addressed in the near future.

There being no further business, Melanie Dean made a motion to adjourn, Michael Corley seconded. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.
