

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Sarepta met in regular session Tuesday, May 14, 2019 at 6:00 p.m., in the Municipal Building, Sarepta, LA.

Mayor Adkins called the meeting to order and Bro. Todd Pickard opened with prayer. David Neal led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Requests for additions to the agenda were called for. Mayor Adkins asked to add Chief Michael McCullen giving a police department report and changing the date of the June meeting. David Neal made a motion to add these items to the agenda and to approve the agenda, seconded by Michael Corley. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Public comments were called for and unanswered.

Michael Corley read the minutes from the April regular meeting. Heath Warford made a motion to approve the minutes as read. David Neal seconded the motion. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Financial Statements of all funds, including a current budget vs. actual, were presented. David Neal made a motion to approve financial statements as presented, seconded by Michael Corley. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

Mayor Adkins recognized Chief Michael McCullen to give a report. Chief McCullen told the Board that since the last time he gave a report, the department had made eight drug arrests, six of which were drugs located by our canine, three DWIs, one armed robbery, and assisted a local agency with a shooting.

Mayor Adkins presented the 2019-2020 Proposed Budget. A notice will be published in the Minden Press announcing said proposed budget will be available for viewing at the Sarepta Municipal Building beginning May 15, 2019.

After some discussion on the possible repercussions involved with adopting Ordinance 458 Nuisance Dogs & Cats, Michael Corley made a motion to approve Ordinance 458 Nuisance Dogs & Cats. No second made. None in favor, motion died on the floor.

Mayor Adkins told the Board she will not be in town for the regular June meeting due to an LMA Executive Board meeting in Baton Rouge. She asked the Board if June 10th or the 13th would be better. Michael Corley made a motion to change the June meeting to the 13th, seconded by David Neal. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

There being no further business, Melanie Dean made a motion to adjourn, David Neal seconded. All in favor, no opposed, motion carried.
